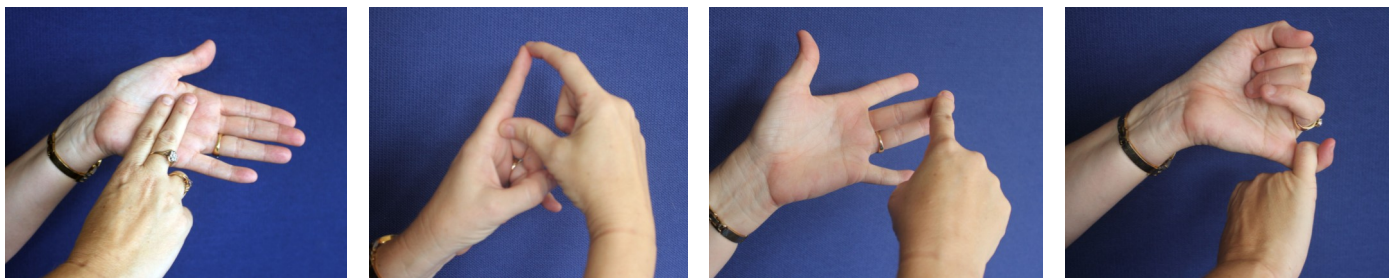


# NDIS TIP SHEET



## GETTING READY FOR NDIS

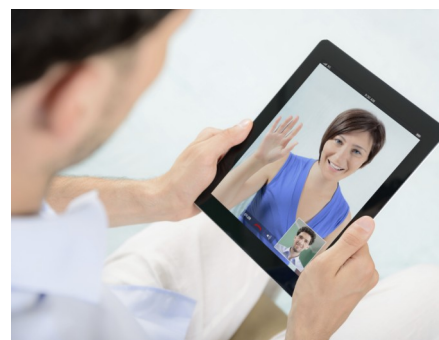
Before you visit the NDIS office, make a list of all the things you need interpreting services for.

*Things like:*

- Your health (visiting doctors, specialists, dentists, physiotherapists and more)
- Your finances (going to the bank, getting financial advice)
- Finding work
- Education
- Parent Teacher interviews
- Things you like to do in the community (your hobbies, sport and other recreational activities)
- Things you want to do in the future which you don't do now without interpreting services (you might like to try something new)

*Technology:*

- What equipment/devices do you have or need?
- Do you need some equipment to make your home more safe? (fire alarm, doorbell alert etc)



## YOUR NDIS PLAN

- ✓ Your NDIS plan should include all the things and services you may use now, or might need later.
- ✓ Even if you use lots of different services, make sure you include them all in your new plan.
- ✓ Ask NDIS for an interpreter for your plan meeting.

## WHEN YOU ARE AT NDIS OFFICE

Make sure you have all the information and understand  
Do not sign paperwork until you are happy with your plan
