

- The City of Darebin is entitled to have a representative present at all times. (This representative would be a non-paid observer. A production company is only responsible for the payment of Council staff if the nature of filming requires a representative of the Council to be present.)
- The production company will ensure all cast, crew and other persons in its employ follow all conditions and any reasonable directions given by the City of Darebin, or its delegate.
- The production company ensures that all information provided in/or attached to the Application is true and correct and that no material or relevant information has been omitted.
- A public liability insurance policy indemnifying the Council to a minimum of \$10,000,000 is to be taken out by the production company. A copy is to be forwarded to the Council on application.
- The production company acknowledges that it conducts the filming entirely at its own risk and hereby releases to the fullest extent permitted by the law, the City of Darebin and its servants, agents and contractors in the absence of any willful default on their part from all claims of every kind resulting from any accident, death or injury occurring at the location to any person or property.
- Local traders and residents in the immediate vicinity of the proposed filming are to be notified in writing no less than 7 days before filming to ensure they have no objections to the filming or associated activities. A copy of this notification must be forwarded to the Council on application.
- The production company must notify all effected services (Victorian Police, The Metropolitan Fire Brigade, The Metropolitan Ambulance Service and if applicable any affected Public Transport services within 7 days prior to filming.
- Where applicable the production company must first obtain permission from the relevant departments of the City of Darebin to use Council parklands, reserves or other Council facilities and make payment of any applicable fees before any permit will be issued.
- Requests for reserved parking must be made 7 days prior to filming clearly identifying the location and number of spaces required. However, there is no guarantee that the spaces will be made available.
- The production company will ensure all dangerous substances and articles to be brought on to location will be listed as such in the Application. Before permission may be given, the production company will provide evidence of competence and working safety, as according to the Film & Television Industry Safety Guidance Notes (1995). No other dangerous articles or substances may be brought onto the location than those listed in the Permit.
- The production company will not allow any willful damage or permanent alterations to be done to the location or contents of the location without express prior permission in writing from the Council.
- The production company will restore the location to the condition it was in, prior to filming.
- The production company will repair all damage at the location for which it has been responsible.
- The production company will remove all its personal property and rubbish from the location at the end of the use of the location.

- The City of Darebin reserves the right to restrict the noise levels of any amplification equipment or other activity it deems unacceptable to the good amenities of the neighbourhood.
- The production company will not do, or allow to be done, any act that will become an annoyance or disturbance to owners, tenants or neighbours.
- Any other expenses or outgoings the City of Darebin is subject to, or may reasonably incur, as a result of the filming, or its need to supervise the filming are expenses to be paid within 14 days of completion of filming by the production company.
- Any bond, less deductions made in accordance with the Conditions or Special Conditions, will be refunded within 14 days of completion of filming at the location.
- The production company may be required to make payment of a bond to the City of Darebin not less than 24 hours prior to the filming date. This bond may be applied by the Council at its sole discretion to repair any damage or replace any losses as a consequence of the filming including unpaid fees or service charges. The balance will be refunded by the council within 14 days of the completion of the use of the location.
- The Permit, the Conditions, Special Conditions and any executed Location Agreement (if applicable) are the entire agreement between the production company and the Council, and no external document or oral statement will be admitted in evidence to amend, alter or vary them.
- The production company will not portray the City of Darebin as endorsing or supporting any product or service or any views, opinions, attitudes or ideas suggested, conveyed, advertised, canvassed, depicted or otherwise expressed, without prior written consent from the Council.
- The production company will, if requested by the City of Darebin, acknowledge the assistance of the Council in the production by the usual method of end credits, or as mutually agreed.
- The City of Darebin may cancel any approval in the event of the activities conducted not being in accordance with those indicated at the time of application.
