Council Meeting Governance Rules (Meeting Procedures and Common Seal) Local Law (No.1 of 2020)

Pursuant to Section 11993) of the *Local Government Act 1989* the City of Darebin at its Ordinary Council meeting on Monday 16 March 2020 resolved to adopt its Council Meeting

Governance Rules (Meeting Procedures and Common Seal) Local Law (No.1 of 2020) with minor changes to clauses 46(1), 65(3), 68(1) and 72(1). These changes are detailed in the minutes of the Council Meeting.

The local law is effective from **Tuesday 7 April 2020**

The purpose and general purport of the Local law is to:

- regulate proceedings at Council and Special Committee meetings and other meetings conducted by or on behalf of Council where Council has resolved that the provisions of the Local Law are to apply;
- regulate the proceedings for the election of the Mayor, Deputy Mayor (if any) and Chairpersons of Committees;
- regulate the use of the common seal;
- make provision for related administrative procedures; and
- provide for the peace, order and good government of the municipal district.
