


Working for Victoria Frequently Asked Questions



What is Working for Victoria?

The Victorian Government has provided \$500 million to the Working for Victoria initiative to help our community and contribute to Victoria's ability to respond to coronavirus (COVID-19).

The Working for Victoria initiative aims to help our community by matching everyday Australians, including those who have lost their job as a result of the impacts of the Coronavirus pandemic, with local governments to deliver critical services and projects for communities.

Darebin Council has received funding under the Victorian Government's Working for Victoria program, with 110 roles, for a six-month duration.

The Working for Victoria online platform matches jobseekers who are ready to work with employers who are looking for skilled and talented employees.

How can I participate in the Working for Victoria initiative?

Working for Victoria has partnered with Sidekicker. To participate in the program and be able to apply for jobs you will need to register through [Working for Victoria](#) and provide information about your job preferences, skills and experience. From there you will start receiving targeted updates about available employment opportunities that match your interests, skills and experience.

Who is eligible for the jobs?

If you are unemployed or your income has been significantly impacted by the Coronavirus pandemic and you are legally allowed to work in Australia, then you are eligible to apply.

Are these jobs for Darebin City Council residents only or can anyone apply?

Anyone can apply but a requirement of the Working for Victoria funding is to prioritise suitable local applicants first. This does not mean that people living outside Darebin can't apply. All potential applicants interested in any of our positions are encouraged to apply. Applicants can select their job location preference upon signing up to Sidekicker.

I'm an international student on a student visa. Can I apply?

Yes. If you are legally allowed to work in Australia, then you are eligible to register.

I was unemployed before coronavirus. Can I apply?

Yes. If you are legally allowed to work in Australia, then you are eligible to register.

I'm a business owner with no income. Can I apply?

Yes. If you are legally allowed to work in Australia, then you are eligible to register.

Are job seeker applicants accepted?

Anyone who's had their income and employment opportunities significantly impacted due to Coronavirus pandemic can apply. If you're on JobSeeker due to Coronavirus pandemic, then you're eligible.

Can I apply if I have an existing job?

If your employment has been significantly impacted by the Coronavirus pandemic you can apply.

How many of the new jobs are full-time? Or are they temporary/part time positions?

All roles are for a six-month term. There are up to 110 full time positions available, however part-time applicants will also be considered.

What types of jobs will they be and when will these positions be starting?

How long do these jobs go for?

The Working for Victoria initiative will fund these roles on a six-month basis.

What locations will the new jobs be in?

The new jobs as part of Darebin City Council's Working for Victoria program will be based within Darebin.

Will I remain employed after the six months?

The positions are funded for a six-month period.

Do I require a Police Check?

Some positions will require a Police Check.

Will PPE be provided?

Yes. PPE will be provided.

Will Council provide me with an induction?

Yes. Council will provide you with an induction.

Will Council provide devices to do the different roles?

Positions that require devices will be provided with devices.

Will these jobs be face to face or working from home?

Some jobs will be face to face and some will be working from home. Where positions are required to be face to face, these positions will be carried out in a way that complies with requirements set out by government. As such, at any given time, these positions are subject to change.
